



## **Assessment at Maple**

Children at Maple Primary School are assessed both summatively and formatively within the Age-Related Expectations (ARE) for their year group.

Each term, children in Years 2-5 take NFER Assessment Tests in Reading and children in Year 1-5 take HfL Assessment tests in Mathematics.

Formative and summative assessments ensure high quality classroom practice throughout the academic year and will inform the annual written reports.

## **DfE Statutory Assessments**

### **Reception Baseline Assessment**

Within the first 6 weeks of joining the Reception class, children take the Reception Baseline Assessment (RBA).

The RBA became statutory in schools in September 2021. It is an activity-based assessment of pupils' starting points in:

- language, communication and literacy
- mathematics

The RBA is a short, task-based assessment. It is not used to label or track individual pupils.

Schools are required to carry out the assessment within the first 6 weeks of children starting reception. No numerical score is shared and the data will only be used at the end of Year 6 to form the school-level progress measure.

### **Phonics Screening Check**

Year 1 take the Phonics Screening Check in the Summer Term.

### **End of Key Stage 1**

The 2022/23 year was the final year of statutory KS1 assessment for Year 2. This academic year there will be no KS1 data collection.

### **Multiplication Tables Check**

Year 4 take the Multiplication Tables Check in the Summer term.

### **End of Key Stage 2**

Year 6 take the National end of Key Stage tests in the Summer Term.
