



In school we recycle:

- **White and coloured A4 paper.**

In every classroom, in the Staffroom and by the network printers there are boxes for collecting the paper. Through the Recycle for Learning Programme the paper is collected and exchanged for points.

We 'spend' our points on recycled sugar paper to use in school.

- All other **paper** is collected in larger boxes in each classroom and emptied into the large bin in the recycling shed and then the Council collects it.
- Small pieces of **Cardboard** are collected in the bin in the Hall (By the Eco Schools Notice Board). The bin is emptied into the green bins outside.
Larger boxes etc are collapsed down and put straight into the green bins and the Council empties these fortnightly.
- Bins for **collecting plastic** are in the dining room and the Staffroom.
- We recycle **batteries** – these are collected in the HIU
- We also recycle our **printer cartridges**.
- There is a small **compost** bin close to the KS1 raised beds.
