

English:

In English this term we are going to be looking at poetry, suspense and mystery and information texts. For our suspense and mystery topic we are going to be looking at 'The Boy in the Tower'. In Spelling, Comprehension and Grammar we are going to continue with our work on reading comprehension as well as touching upon parenthesis, expanded noun phrases and tenses. In addition, we have our weekly guided reading session; building on from the inference work last term, we are going to be drawing on a variety of texts throughout the week, as well as continuing our group sessions on a Friday. Please remember to write in your reading diaries for our class competition (we have still not managed to reach a week yet but were very close last term!). You do not need to just write about our Guided reading book as it can be on any book you are reading, but with the specific Guided Reading focus. Our Spelling tests will continue to be on a Thursday morning.
